PHEBRA SIGNS DISTRIBUTION AGREEMENT FOR DIGIFAB™

The Australian pharmaceutical company, Phebra, today announced it had signed an exclusive distribution agreement with Protherics Medicines Development Ltd, a BTG International group company, for the distribution rights in Australia and New Zealand for DigiFab[™] (digoxin immune fab (ovine)), an antidote for the treatment of patients suffering life-threatening digoxin toxicity.

Although DigiFab[™] has not received marketing approval in Australia or New Zealand, Phebra's Chief Executive Officer, Dr Mal Eutick, commented that the company intends to pursue marketing authorisation in these countries.
